【Function】

- Discussion to develop and adopt measures to remove regulatory and non-regulatory barriers
- Approval for launching projects and its outcome

【Members】

【Core elements】

- **Regulatory and policy cooperation**
- **Facilitate public-private engagement**

Process management, helping the chairs of GP and the SP, and other tasks by **Permanent Secretariat**

Establishment of projects for **“test and implementation”** based on the approval of both panels

Can be based on the Elements of G7 Digital Ministerial (TBD)

【Examples of Projects】

- **Enhancing transparency**
- **Certification of data quality** (fact check/alternation history/geocoding etc)
- **Privacy** (PETs/RegTech)
- **Other aspects for enhancing interoperability**
- **...and various projects to be implemented.**

- Approval for launching projects and its outcome

- Business, universities and other entities
- Experts from the IOs etc
